- Cameron and Renee brought up their displeasure with the curvature of the EJs on the wall closer to
 the lower parking lot. At the top of the expansion joints, it appears the Summit Geostructures did not
 straighten them and left bends and swoops in them. Cameron said that the bends and curvatures are
 very noticeable from the road and asked how that can be fixed. M-M and WRS decided it would be
 best to put Keller on notice sooner rather than later as getting them back on site in short notice will
 be very hard. Tim and Willie discussed putting together a punch list that captures all the work/rework
 Keller needs to complete on the wall.
