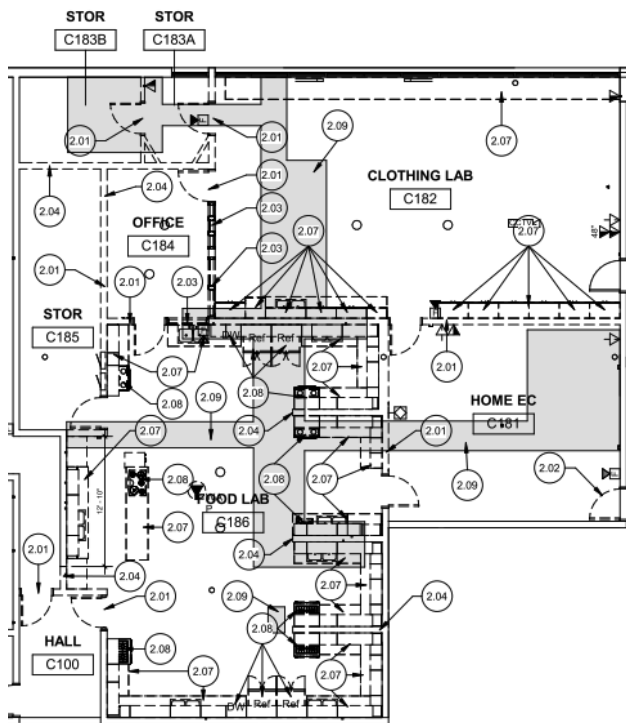

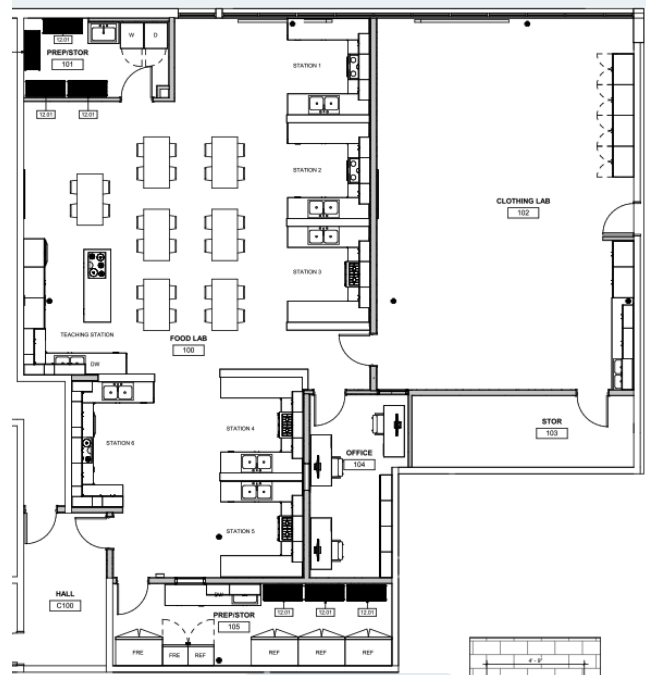

SUBJ: **Approval of SHS FACS Renovation (Action)**

The high school was built in 1987, making the Family and Consumer Science room 37 years old. Class capacity is 24 students and courses include Child and Family Studies, Hospital and Restaurant Management, Introduction to Early Childhood Education, Foods and Nutrition, Global Cuisine, Interior Design, Clothing and Fashion Design, Rebel Chef, and Culinary Professionals.

Bids Received:

The district received one bid from In-Yarak Construction. Two other bidders took out the plans, but due to additional workloads on existing projects, chose not to submit. The bid came in as follows:

Total: \$1,614,000

The estimate was \$1.2 million. However, the contractor suggested that if the district could move the substantial completion date back two weeks to August 23rd, more subs would submit, ultimately lowering the cost. The district agreed to the August 23rd substantial completion date and has chosen to accept both alternates. With these changes, the bid is now at \$1,476,000, saving \$138,000 from the original bid. This project optimizes a great design that will facilitate an efficient space for teachers and a superior educational area for students.

I recommend the Board approve In-Yarak Construction for \$1,476,000 to renovate the FACS room, using major maintenance funds.
